### TRAINING TO SPECIALIZE FOR THE RECOGNITION AND SUPPORT OF THE VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING AND SEXUAL EXPLOITATION

#### Short introduction

It's important to introduce a gender perspective in trafficking prevention training initiatives; Gender is the element at the base of the vulnerability of populations and individuals: it is found that women are the most discriminated subjects in the world, most exposed to become potential victims of trafficking, and it should also be considered that customers of the services offered by people trafficked for sexual exploitation are all men.

The phenomenon of trafficking and sexual exploitation intersects with the macro theme of forced migration, as a consequence reception in Italy is increasingly finding itself interfacing with female users who can hide a situation behind fleeing their country of violence and exploitation that continues to perpetrate in the port country.

The course, starting from a general overview of the phenomenon of trafficking in human beings, focuses on the topics of:

- sexual exploitation;
- labor exploitation,

with the aim of providing useful concrete tools to be able to recognize and intervene in all those cases where you have the feeling or the certainty that a person / guest is a victim of trafficking.

We therefore want to accompany the operators, to reach a certain sensitivity and awareness, and to give them knowledge and tools so that they can recognize and welcome with the correct specialist interventions and with the right transversal skills the women and men who continue to live in Italy / Europe a form of modern slavery.

The training proposal includes a frontal part and a part of activities to be carried out in a group through experiential role playing, simulations and the study of real cases.
